Orienteering Queensland welcomes orienteers to the 2017 Middle Distance Championships to be held at the picturesque Wivenhoe Dam. The assembly area is at the Spillway Common Picnic Area in front of the dam wall.

Online Entry Opens: Saturday 13 June 2017 Closes: Midnight Sunday 16 July 2017 THERE IS NO ENTRY OR PAY ON THE DAY. PLEASE PRE ENTER AND PAY VIA EVENTOR.

^{*} Parents please note that the Easy and Very Easy courses use the internal road network in the Wivenhoe Spillway Common. These roads are expected to be quiet and signs will be displayed regarding runners being on the roads, however please consider this if you are considering entering children on these courses.

Terrain: The terrain is mostly open forest with good runability. There are interesting areas of spur-gully areas and also rock and cliff features on steep slopes. There are minimal patches of lantana and the areas of long grass have been avoided.





Directions: The assembly area is at The Spillway Common Picnic Area immediately in front of the Wivenhoe Dam wall.

If approaching the dam **from the south**, travel 6.7km from Fernvale to the sign-posted left turn into The Spillway Common (1.9km before the dam wall). Follow the orienteering signs for a further 2.5km to the assembly area at the Picnic Area.

If approaching from the dam **from the north**, cross the dam wall and travel 1.9km to the sign-posted right turn into the Spillway Common. Follow the orienteering signs for a further 2.5km to the assembly area at the Picnic Area.

Park in the car parks of the Picnic area or otherwise as directed.

Water: Will be available on the courses at designated control sites. Otherwise Bring Your

Own. Soft drinks will be for sale.
