Terrain: Fast Gully/Spur but offering challenges in navigation with gentle gullies and broken watercourses including small depressions, ponds and termite mounds. There is some grass seed on course so leg covering and taping is recommended.

Directions: Travelling from Brisbane, cross Wivenhoe Dam and continue on for approximately 4.2km. Turn right into Hay Rd. Continue around to the right into Fig Tree Road. From Esk travel approximately 25km and turn left into Hay Rd.

Parking: At the intersection of Fig Tree Road and Sheepstation Inlet Road. Please park as directed. There is a 400m walk to the assembly area.

Registration: As this is a pre —entry event there is no need to go to the registration table, unless you have outstanding payment owing or to collect a hired SI stick.

Maps: Maps are printed on 100gsm bond paper. Plastic covers will be available at the start.

Start: 600m walk to the start from the assembly area.

Clear and Check your SI stick.

Collect your control descriptions for your course and stand behind the map tray with your course marked on it. Wait for the starter to start you.

Insert your SI stick in the unit at the pre-start and then follow the streamers to the start triangle which will be marked on your map. You MUST go to the start triangle. There will be a control flag there but no punch.

Download tent: After punching the finish control follow the tapes to the download tent. You must proceed to the download tent even if you abandon your course. There will be water near the download tent.

Results: You will receive a splits printout with a detachable result tab. Could you please assist by inserting your result tab in the plastic holders provided and then attaching your result to the results hanger.

Safety:

Brisbane Valley Highway is a busy road. Please TAKE CARE when turning into Hay Road. Early warning turn signage will be in place from both directions.

Facilities:

<u>Toilets</u>: There is a toilet on Sheepstation Inlet Road 250m form the intersection with Fig Tree Road. There will be **NO** toilets at the assembly area.

<u>Water</u>: This will be available on the courses at designated locations and control sites and also there will be some in the assembly area. To help the organiser it would help if you brought some for your personal use before and after your run.

Drinks Ice cold Soft drinks are available for sale near the Results.
