Tuckonie Orienteers put on a good event, blessed with fine weather for 152 entrants. The courses presented variety with different types of country to traverse and an interesting selection of easy and harder going. Many legs gave a choice of route.

We saw the consistently good orienteers at the top of Senior Mens, and Sue Weate had a clear margin of 16 min in Senior Women's. Sue saved time between No.4 ('the spur') and no.5 ('the creek junction') by avoiding the prickly bush on either bank of the creek, which lay along the direct route. Sue strode right up the creek where the water depth varied from ankle depth to hip depth. Lucky she didn't trip over!

Veterans attracted 16 starters, the largest field to date.

In the interclub contest the first four teams finished within 35 min. of each other on the aggregate of the four best adjusted times. Bayside, handicapped by absences of 4 usual team members, were a long way behind.
