Arena The Arena is located in Site 6 at the western end of the Scout Park.

Toilets available

Terrain The scout park is located along a ridge which has been cleared in places for camping. The scout

park is divided into sites, which are bounded by forest. There are many buildings, fences and other man made objects. The open areas are surrounded by forest, of varying runability. There

are steep watercourses to the north and west.

The light green on the map varies from white to light green

The fire trail at the bottom left of the map is part of the Sydney Catchment Area and is out of

bounds. Large fines apply.

Enter on Day: Enter on Day will be available on Very Easy, Easy, Moderate and Hard 3 courses

Fees- Sub Junior \$7.50 Junior \$15 Senior \$27

Start: The start is within 300m of the arena. There will be no toilets or water at the start. No clothing

return.

Start Procedure

Box 1	-3 minutes	Name check	Make sure you have cleared & checked
Box 2	-2 minutes	Collect control descriptions	Loose descriptions will be available for all courses. Sticky tape not provided
Box 3	-1 minute	Map tray	Check you are at the right map tray. No need to write name on map
	0 minute	Punch start unit before looking at your map	Enjoy your run

Officials will be available at the start to help students who may require assistance to orient their map and know which way to head to the first control.

Map trays will be clearly labelled with the Course name and each Class running that Course.

Maps will not be collected after your run. Please do not show your map to any competitor who has not started their course.

Finish Procedure

After punching a finish control please proceed directly to the download tent. Here you will download twice. The 1st download will provide you with your split times and the 2nd download provides you with a result label which you stick on a timber slat and then hang, in time order, under your age class on the result boards.

Timing devices

All competitors are required to use a SI stick. They are to be collected from the Registration Tent at least 30 minutes before the start of your first event . This SI stick has been allocated to you for all the events you have entered. It will be collected at the Finish table at the completion of your last event. Do not swap with another runner. Lost sticks must be paid for.

Whistles

Whistles will be provided for all Schools competitors. These are to be collected from the Registration Tent before

you go to the start of the first event you have entered.

Control Descriptions

Control descriptions will be on each map. They will also be available at the start. Competitors in the NSW Schools champs can collect their control descriptions when they register. Schools championships classes will have English control descriptions on the back of the map and international symbols on the front. All other course maps will have international symbols on the front of the map.
