Terrain: Broad sandy creeks and rocky hillsides with native pines, and the Adelaide-Melbourne railway line running through the middle of the valley. Courses cross under the line at **MANDATORY CROSSING POINTS**

Camping: tents and camper-trailers/caravans may be set up from 4pm onwards; please park as directed. This area has just become part of Kinchina Conservation Park and we are very lucky to be allowed to camp here overnight at no charge; however, dogs, campfires and alcohol are expressly forbidden.
