About This Event:

This will be a scatter event where controls will be placed throughout the mapped area and participants will have to visit all controls in the quickest time in any order. There will be three separate courses for the scatter plus a line mini course for the youngsters.

- Enjoy suburban street orienteering.
- Walk or run with your mates, friends or family.
- Four courses to suit all ages and fitness levels.

Where is the Start?

The registration and start are at the barbecue shelters on Beach Road Ulverstone behind the football oval, opposite the water slide.

When Can I Start?

Start times are between 10.00am and 12.30pm, with course closure at 2.00pm. Starting as early as possible gives you more time to complete the course.

When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 2.00pm. If you will not be able to complete your course in time you will need to abandon it and head back to the assembly area to arrive by course closure time. Whether or not you have completed your course, you must download your SI at the computer, so that we know you have returned safely, and don't organise a search party for you. Also be aware that as soon as the course is closed, the organisers start bringing in controls.

What Are The Courses?

Long: 4.8 km

Medium: 3.5 km

Short Novice: 1.9 km

Mini: 1.0 km

Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events. Please note that P-cards are not suitable for courses with more than 19 controls, so talk to the registration team if you have this

problem.
