About This Event:

Third event of the three day is a middle distance event.

The terrain is a great mix of runnable forest, sections of complex detail with rock and old mining areas, finishing in open farmland. Assembly area is near a scenic dam which may be nice if the weather is hot

9 course levels are available for all levels, the easy levels staying close to the assembly area and away from the more complex areas.

The hard navigation courses do cross areas with some mapped but not taped deep mining pits, some caution needed around mapped deep pits.

Where is the Start?

<The course starts on farmland access via a farm track 12.7 km from Avoca and the southern side of the Royal George road. The gate on the opposite side of the road is just past Robinslawn homestead and St Paul's River Cabin sign.

A well maintained farm track provides easy access for all cars and there is plenty parking with a short walk to the assembly area .

When Can I Start?

You can start anytime between 10 am and 12am. Starting as early as possible gives you more time to complete the course.

When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 1pm If you will not be able to complete your course in time you will need to abandon it and head back to the assembly area to arrive by course closure time. Whether or not you have completed your course, you must download your SI at the computer, so that we know you have returned safely, and don't organise a search party for you. Also be aware that as soon as the course is closed, the organisers start bringing in controls.

Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events. Please note that P-cards are not suitable for courses with more than 19 controls, so talk to the registration team if you have this problem.
