Directions Take Main South Road / Southern Expressway to Old Noarlunga. At the second set of lights go straight ahead to Aldinga and KI (B23), instead of veering left to McLaren Vale. After 5km turn left into Tatachilla Rd (well signed). Then, after 2.5km turn right at the second crossroads into California Rd.

Parking Park in the bays on the left. Parking is also allowed on the right verge until the No Parking sign.

Enter on the Day There will be a limited number of maps available of the above courses for Male and Female categories in each course. Enter on the Day classes will not be classified as championship classes.

Start Times Start times are from 10a.m. until 11:30a.m. Start times will be available on Eventor by Friday 10pm. Course closure will be 1p.m.

Late Starters Late Starters ... of course there will be no late starters.

Maps Maps will be printed on waterproof paper. The scale is 1:3,000 with 3m contours.

Warm-up Area Warm-ups will only be allowed up California Rd (a fairly quiet country road).

Registration and Prestart Areas From California Rd enter the college through the 'O' signed pedestrian gate. This will lead across a carpark to a covered amphitheatre area where the prestarts, registration, toilets and water will be. This area is NOT to be used by runners on their courses.

Arena Bring a picnic rug or chairs. Watch the fun and action from an elevated position with good views of the Finish line. Toilets are nearby. Enjoy a mini-sprint exercise while waiting. There is also a playground and sandpit area for children.

Out of Bounds All areas of the college, other than those mentioned above, are Out of Bounds until you have started your race. Little Athletics competition will be happening on the oval so the oval and any areas they are using is Out of Bounds. Their cars will be parked around the oval so take care when running there.

Bridge / Elevated walkway



Elevated walkways on the map are drawn with the bridge symbol. As they are generally overhead in relation to the surrounding terrain they are filled with the grey canopy screen.

Shoes Spiked shoes are not allowed.

Sewerage Courses 1, 2 & 3 - if when you are running through planted eucalypt areas the irrigation system should come on, do not internalise the water as apparently it is poorly diluted sewerage.

Afterwards After the event when you turn back onto Tatachilla Rd, the tourist town of McLaren Vale is two kms to your right and the beautiful Maslins Beach (choice of nudist or non-nudist sections) is four kms to your left.
