Saturday 12 May: ACT Sprint Distance Championships - 2018 ACT League # 5, NSW State League #5

Venue: Canberra Grammar School, Monaro Cres, Red Hill. The ARENA will be within the school grounds. There will be a taped route to the ARENA area with the entry from Monaro Crescent. Further d21etails will be provided in the final bulletin.

Starts: Championship starts will be from 2pm with pre-entry on Eventor only. There will be an enter on the day event with Easy, Very Easy and Moderate courses before the main event from 12 until 1:00pm as part of the local Saturday program.

Map: Canberra Grammar School. 1:4,000. 2.5m contours. This map was last used at the Australian Sprint Championships in 2013 but has been extensively remapped with new buildings, gardens and play grounds. The campus is small but complex. The competition area will be within the School campus, which is predominantly buildings, pathways, roads, car parks and associated vegetation, with some changes of level requiring careful route choice. Courses will have one to two spectator controls adjacent to the ARENA.

Venue: Orroral East, Namadgi National Park.

How to Get There: Head south of Canberra through Tuggeranong along Tharwa Drive, proceed further south, cross historic wooden bridge over Murrumbidgee River, through village of Tharwa. Continue south along Naas Road, then continue south, road becomes Boboyan Road. Over Fitz's Hill. Then turn right into Orroral Road. Parking at the carpark, near the campground.

Starts will be from 10am

Map: Orroral East. 1:10 000. 5m contours.

Classic Namadgi Terrain with gorgeous granite features of all sizes. The challenge of using smart route choices to avoid some more dense patches of vegetation, particularly near the river. Native eucalyptus vegetation with some clearings and a main road and some minor foot tracks to assist in navigation. Very pretty river - the Orrorol - running through the map and past the assembly area.
