



Mountain Bike Orienteering

Sunday 24th June Esk State Forest



The Multi Terrain Bike Orienteers Club will be holding Round 5 of the 2018 series at Esk State Forest, 12km Southwest of Esk (approx 1 and a half hours from Brisbane, 2 hours from the Sunshine Coast)

Esk has a network of fire trails and some single track through pine and native forest. There will be 6 courses to suit all levels of fitness and abilities including three Open classes (Long, Medium, Short) and a Score class for teams and families. Control points will be placed on obvious features such as track junctions and creek crossings.
