Come experience a fast, fun new map near Ipswich. Undulating to steep spur gully with some patches of rock, on a base of open grassland and forest.





Ripley Rifle Range, ISOM 2017 (new map!) Scale 1:10,000 for all courses except Easy and Very Easy, which are 1:7,500

Black circles on the map represent archery targets (see left map excerpt). In accordance with ISOM 2017, termite mounds are mapped as brown triangles, which may look unfamiliar (see right excerpt). Black crosses on the map are piles of metal rubbish, take care when running near them.

Directions

From Brisbane: Take the M5 south to Springfield. Continue past Springfield on the A5/Centenary Hwy for 4km to the roundabout at Ripley Rd. Turn left and continue on Ripley Rd for 7.5km, then turn left at the O-signs. The event is 1.5km from the turn along this road, allow 50 minutes from Brisbane centre.

From Toowoomba: Take the Warrego Hwy for 70km, then turn right onto Haigslea Amberley Rd. Follow this for 10km then turn left onto Ipswich Rosewood Road, then turn left onto the Cunningham Hwy. Exit after 4km onto the Centenary Hwy, then follow the Centenary Hwy for 5km until the roundabout with Ripley Rd. Use Brisbane directions from here, allow 90 minutes from Toowoomba centre.

If you are entering please note the family entry fee is \$36 for members and \$54 for non-members plus any SI hires. If you are a non-member family wanting to enter please contact Tony <u>treasurer@oq.asn.au</u> to ensure you are charged the correct amount. Member families entering, please enter together. Use the services function in Eventor to reduce the overall fee to \$36. There is a \$4 discount and an \$8 discount service to use. Eg.2 adults and 2 children – Use \$4 discount. Or 1 adult 4 children use the \$8 discount. Any concerns with entering please contact Tony <u>treasuer@oq.asn.au</u> to ensure you are charged the correct amount.

Entries close midnight the Wednesday before the event.

Facilities

There will be water on the course and a limited supply at the Assembly Area. Please bring enough water for your own needs.

There will be Porta-loos at the Assembly Area.

Notes

Grass seeds may be quite extensive depending on the weather, so gaiters are recommended. Some creeks and waterholes may be dry, again depending on the weather.

There is a 1km walk from the assembly area to the start. Parking is adjacent to the assembly area.

Easy course runners should be able to run past controls that are not theirs, and potentially go past some of their own controls on a route.
