



Ballinafad Creek, 24 June 2018, Event notes

Directions

From Queanbeyan:

Take Kings Highway 3km to the Captains Flat Road turnoff.

Continue to Captains Flat.

At Captains Flat turn right into Foxlow Street

Continue on (veer right) into Jerangle Road (O sign)

Continue on Jerangle Road 11.3 km to Wild Cattle Flat Road

Turn left into Wild Cattle Flat Road (O sign)

Drive 4km to Wild Cattle Flat Fire Trail on right

Turn into the paddock (O sign)

Note – by June the Jerangle Road may be sealed all the way to Wild Cattle Flat Road. Wild Cattle Flat Road is quite good dirt road.

Course setter's notes

Map

For Red 1 & 2 Ballinafad Creek 1:15000, for all other courses 1:10000. 5m contour interval.

Terrain

Classic spur gully with tall forest and a couple of large hills. Many termite mounds. Some flatter marshy areas which in late June may be really wet!

Red 1	10.7 km	14 controls
Red 2	8.0 km	9 Controls
Red 3	6.4 km	8 Controls
Red 4	4.2 km	7 Controls
Red 5	3.4 km	7 Controls
Orange 1	3.8 km	7 Controls
Orange 2	3.0 km	5 Controls
Green	1.9 km	8 Controls
Blue	1.6 km	6 Controls

Safety

To the south and east are extensive areas of forest with few roads/tracks. Competitors must carry a whistle – no whistle no start. The safety bearing will be on the map – north to either Wild Cattle Flat Road or Wild Cattle Flat Fire Trail then back to the assembly area east along the road or west along the fire trail. **All competitors must clear and check their SI sticks and report to the finish tent before leaving the event even if they have not successfully completed their course.**

Toilets

There will be 1 portaloos.

Weather

If there is heavy snow or floods the event will be postponed.
