Venue: Kahli's Rocks West


From Bathurst head west on Mitchell Highway. Travel time about 20 mins.

From Orange head east on Mitchell Highway. Travel time about 32mins.

Starts: Queuing starts will be from 12:30 with pre-entry on Eventor. There will also be limited enter on the day courses on offer with Easy, Very Easy, Moderate and Hard 5 course options. Enter on the day courses can start from 1:00pm until 3:00pm.

Map: Kahli's Rocks West



1:10,000 5m contour intervals. Originally mapped by Eric Andrews.

This area is renowned for its granite rocky detail. The western area has rock clusters and is gently undulating ranging from open fast paddock to eucalypt forest with patches of slower running with low visibility. Due to access restrictions the courses will not pass into the steeper rocky slopes.

The extent of the western area is marked on the previous map, available in Eventor.

Note: Access to the area has not been allowed, until recently, and we are very grateful to have access to a portion of the map. Please respect adjacent landowners wishes and do not pass into the out of bounds areas on the map.

Venue: Ophir South

From Bathurst, drive towards Orange, taking the Northern Distributor road to the right, prior to entering Orange itself. Turn right at the round about onto Ophir Rd and take the right hand turn into Banjo Patterson Way. Travel time about 1 hr.

From Orange, drive north on Ophir Rd, take the right hand turn onto Banjo Patterson Way. Travel time about 30 mins.

The terrain is predominantly open eucalypt forest with rolling spur gully, and areas of detailed gold mining, steep rocky gullies, and rock detail.



## Ophir Camping:



Camping is available at the Ophir Reserve, on the scenic banks of Summer Hill Creek. Steel picnic tables, barbecue facilities and a toilet block are available.

Camping costs \$10 per car or camp site. Camping fees help with the maintenance and upkeep of the Ophir Reserve, which is administered by volunteers. Camping fees can be paid at the honesty box on site, to one of the Ophir Trust Members if they visit, or purchased at Orange Visitor

Information Centre, Byng Street, Orange (ph: 1800 069 466).

Camping is accessed from Banjo Patterson Way (which turns into Lower Lewis Ponds Rd), Off Ophir Rd, 25km from Orange.

Note: the area outside the campground, either side of the access road to the south is out of bounds prior to your start.
