Enter on the day

Enter on the day is available for four courses – a Very Easy, an Easy, a Moderate and a Hard navigation course. Enter on the day competitors should register at the caravan after 1pm and will start their courses after all of the championship competitors have started.

Extra Information

Parents it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to supervise your children at all times. The river and bridge are particularly appealing to the young.

The area is fairly steep. The setter has tried to make the runs as fast and as orienteering friendly as possible. To enable this the starts are well up the hill. Older and less fit individuals are recommended to leave the car park **well before** their start time (suggest 30 – 40 minutes) to recover from the slog up the hill. Also, before you start on your walk to the Start make sure you have all you need for the event as it is along way back if you forget something!

To get to the starts - cross the bridge and make your way to the finish banner. The starts will be signposted from here.

There are two starts – a Course 6 & 7 start and a Courses 1 - 5 start. Both will be signposted.

The caravan will be placed as near as possible to the bridge for registration of enter on the day competitors.

The area near the Finish banner will be ideal for a picnic (weather permitting) and for viewing incoming competitors and the final presentations.

Directions

The WA Middle Distance Championships is at Jumbuck Hill. Parking is at Bells Rapids. Enter Cathedral Avenue from Great Northern Highway and drive through to the end. There is a very narrow section of road where extra care should be taken when entering and exiting the Bells Rapids Carpark.

Parking

There is ample parking at Bells Rapids. Park wisely and **lock your car**. At the time of writing this bulletin there is no parking fee.
