About This Event:

The terrain is complex sand dunes in runnable pine forest with some open sections of grassland dunes. Assembly area on the edge of the complex dune area with views of runners on a number of courses.

There will be nine courses available for all levels from hard navigation courses in the complex dunes to easy navigation courses which use the track networks through the dunes.

Where is the Start?

Travel from Hobart along the Tasman Highway to approximately 1.5km past the Hobart Airport roundabout. Turn right into Pittwater Road and travel for approximately 2.5km and turn left into Centre Road. Travel 4km along Centre Road and follow the orienteering signs to the parking area. Orienteering signs will be located at the Centre Road turnoff and to direct you to the parking area.

Note there are two gates along Centre Road; please ensure these are both shut when you drive through them.

There is plenty of parking with a short walk to the assembly area.

When Can I Start?

This event is a pre-entry only event. A very easy navigation course (Course 9) and a moderate navigation course (Course 7) will be offered for entry on the day.

When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 1.30pm. If you will not be able to complete your course in time you will need to abandon it and head back to the assembly area to arrive by course closure time. Whether or not you have completed your course, you must download your SI at the computer, so that we know you have returned safely, and don't organise a search party for you. Also be aware that as soon as the course is closed, the organisers start bringing in controls. Note that the safety bearing is north to the Centre Road (the gravel road you drive in on) for all courses.

Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events. Please note that P-cards are not suitable for courses with more than 19 controls, so talk to the registration team if you have a P card to ensure it will work for your chosen course; you can hire an e-stick if needed.

Pre-entry via Eventor – Deadline for entries is midnight on Tuesday 28th August 2018. Please let the organisers know if you need split start times.
