- 7 Be part of the action and the exciting commentary as split times and predictions enhance the atmosphere of the sprint championships
- 8 Have a jog around famous Lake Wendouree on the Steve Monaghetti track or check out the city's streets, gardens and historic places in preparation for aMAZEing Ballarat on 7th December - a unique urban adventure race with a difference
