'Bush-Only' Course at Narrogin Sprint

The map for the 2019 Australian Sprint Orienteering Championships at Narrogin Senior High School is surrounded by an extensive area of native bushland, with variable runnability, a complex path network, and several areas with detailed contour/mining-style features created by gravel-quarrying activity.

The Sprint Championship courses will include some legs through this terrain, but with easy control sites and complex route choice decisions in keeping with the Sprint Orienteering Profile (see Appendix 8, Orienteering Australia Competition Rules).

However, if you are not a fan of sprint orienteering, there will be a (non-Championship) course set almost entirely within the bush area of the map.

This course will be approximately 3.0 - 3.5 kms, with Hard difficulty controls and many route choice legs. Be aware however that the map is drawn to Sprint Orienteering standards (ISSOM).

It will be possible to pre-enter this course in Eventor (look for Bush-Only in the Open B categories), or simply enter on the day (EOD). Start times will be allocated for all pre-entered competitors, EOD entries will start after all non-elite Championship competitors have started.

The course map will be available to Elite class competitors (for a small charge) as a 'warm-down' map after they finish their Championship course.
