Map:

Ballarat Grammar and Wendouree Primary School, mapped by Ian Lawford and Belinda Lawford, 2013.

1:4000 scale, 2.5m contours, full colour, using IOF symbols for Sprint Orienteering.

The map is on Pretex paper and will NOT be bagged.

A number of features are marked on the map with a black X (prominent bench or man-made feature). A number of features are marked on the map with a black O (prominent pole).

Areas shown as olive green are out of bounds and must not be crossed. These are mainly garden beds. Features mapped with a thick black line – for example, high fences, concrete walls – must not be crossed.

Terrain:

School campus - buildings, gardens, pathways, man-made features, sportsgrounds and the like.

Event Directions:

The assembly area is in the grounds of Ballarat Grammar, Forest Street Wendouree. Park on either side of Forest Street between Howitt and Norman Streets. Enter the school grounds at Gate D ONLY (300m south of Norman Street 500m North of Howitt Street. The assembly area is at the Pavilion just inside Gate D.

Registration:

The only people that need to come to registration are those who need to pay or those who need to pick up hired SI sticks.

Toilets: Located in the Pavilion on the East side.

Club Tents:

Do NOT erect club tents or banners on the oval as there is a sprinkler system which must not be damaged. Other areas are available for tents or banners.

Shoes:

It is forbidden to compete in shoes with metal spikes of any form on the sole.

Warm up:

Warm up on the east side of the oval on the south side of the Pavilion. Other parts of the school grounds and Forest Street are out of bounds for warming up.

Start:

The Start is located 150m from assembly area.

Start times are pre-allocated. Competitors will start at 1 minute intervals.

The Clear control will be located at the pre-start.

The Start procedure is as follows:

3 mins prior

have your name and SI number checked, and check the SI stick is cleared then move into box 1

2 mins prior

move into box 2 and collect control descriptions (note these are also printed on the maps)

1 min prior

move down to the map boxes. On the 6th beep of the clock, pick up your map and run to the start triangle marked by a control flag (it is

NOT a punch start). DO NOT CROSS THE TAPE marking the route to the Start triangle.

Enter on the Day (EOD):

A limited number of maps will be available for Enter on the Day. These starts will be between 11am and 12 noon. EOD competitors will use a punching start, will not be shown in the results and will not be eligible for prizes. Entry fees will be Senior \$22.00, Junior \$16.00

Catering:

There will be no food or drink for sale on site. Shops are located nearby in Howitt Street.

Prizes/Awards:

Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 men and women on each course. There will also be a prize giving ceremony for the Sprint into Spring Series. This will take place as soon as possible after results are decided.
