

Information for SSS No. 21 (Castlecrag/Northbridge)

The assembly area is in Warners Park, The Outpost, Northbridge.

Arriving by car: You can turn left into Tenilba Rd if travelling south along Eastern Valley Way, but you cannot turn right if travelling north. Approaching from Sailors Bay Rd down Harden Ave is recommended.

Car parking: There is a carpark in Warners Park with space for about 35 cars. It is expected to fill very quickly. Please do NOT park on grassed areas or the private road on the south side of the park – they are not designed for parking.

The Outpost (the entrance road to the park) is narrow and bendy and you are unlikely to find a park there. Better parking options are: Kameruka Rd, Tenilba Rd, Harden Ave and Kyogle Rd. An extension to Kyogle Rd provides a short cut into the park. We will hang an SSS banner there.



Arriving by bus: Buses 202, 203, 204, 205, 206 and 209 travel along Sailors Bay Rd in Northbridge. From the bus stop, go west to Harden Ave and then north to Kameruka Rd and the extension to Kyogle Rd into the park (about 10 minutes).

Toilets: There are two unisex toilets – so at busy times there may be queues.

Course notes: There are many small parks and interesting tracks between residential properties. and the course is designed to use as many as possible.

The starts of the tracks are sometimes difficult to recognise. There are nearly always track markers which are about 80cm high and sometimes plain (1st photo) and sometimes fancy (2nd photo shows a stone marker near a garage).

The start of some tracks coincides with the driveway into a house. The last photo shows a confusing marker - the track goes in front of the large tree (only its trunk is visible) between the marker and the driveway on the right.
