About This Event:

- This is the fourth of eight events that make up the Northern Twilight Series.
- Enjoy suburban street and park orienteering.
- Walk or run on your own or with your mates, friends and family.
- Four courses to suit all ages and fitness levels.

Where is the Start?

From the traffic lights at the corner of Ecclestone Road and West Tamar Road turn down Windsor Drive (towards the river) to the new West Tamar Council health and Wellbeing Centre and watch for signs.

When Can I Start?

You can start anytime between 4pm and 6pm. Starting as early as possible gives you more time to complete the course.

When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 7pm. If you will not be able to complete your course in time you will need to abandon it and head back to the assembly area to arrive by course closure time. Whether or not you have completed your course, you must download your SI at the computer, so that we know you have returned safely, and don't organise a search party for you. Also be aware that as soon as the course is closed, the organisers start bringing in controls.

What Are The Courses?

Course 1: 4.1km Moderate Navigation

Course 2 and Walkers: 3.2km Moderate Navigation

Course 3: 1.8km Easy Navigation

Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events. Please note that P-cards are not suitable for courses with more than 19 controls, so talk to the registration team if you have this problem.
