



## **Selection Criteria for 2019 NSW Schools Orienteering Team**

To be considered as a potential NSW schools team member at the 2019 Australian Schools Championships in the Riverina you will need to:

### **1. Nominate**

by **1 April 2019** by completing the nomination form on Eventor. Please provide your name, school, date of birth and competition class (e.g.W14A).

### **2. Participate**

a) **You MUST compete at the NSW Champs (May 18-19 near Cowra) and the QB III carnival (June 8-10 in the Southern Highlands)** in your A level age class. This means competing on Moderate courses for Junior classes (M/W 14A) and Hard courses for Senior classes (M/W16A or M/W17-20A).

If you are unable to compete, you must notify the Chair of the Selection Panel Rob Bennett ([bennett.robert06@gmail.com](mailto:bennett.robert06@gmail.com)) before the event, stating the reason.

b) You are strongly encouraged to compete in ALL other State League events.

c) Participate in other orienteering events, eg local club events, Metro League, Sprint series.

d) Seniors (MM/W17-20E) are encouraged to race in all NOL events for the NSW Stingers.

### **3. Commit to the sport**

This is demonstrated by attendance at the NSW Development Squad Training Camp in July and, for those aged 16 and over, following a structured training program developed by their coach, mentor and/or parent.

### **Team Announcement**

The schools team will be announced by 30 June 2019 on the Orienteering NSW website. Please note however, that all positions in the team are provisional based on continued participation in events up to the Australian Schools Carnival, attendance at the July training camp and fitness.
