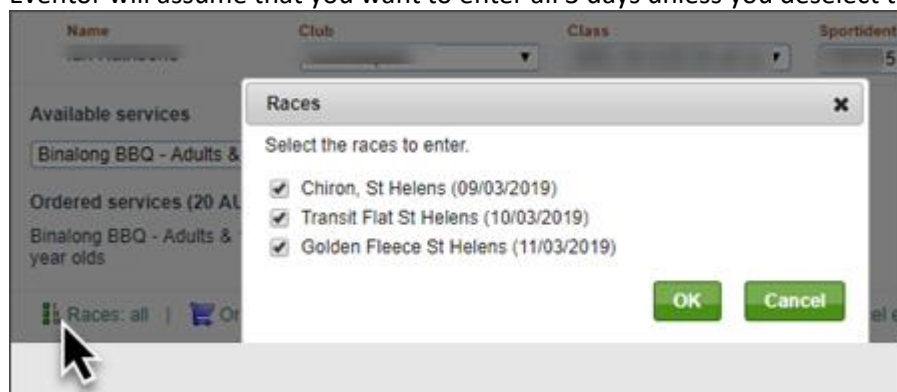

Note 1: Orienteering Tasmania has made changes to Course 5 & 6 regarding which age groups shall run on them and a reduced the expected winning time on course 5. The changes are now W70, W75 and M75 will run Course 5 not 6

Note 2: Parents please note that on Day 1 courses 8 and 9, in addition to other courses, cross Argonaut Rd. Children on these courses need to cross and run along Argonaut Rd. Parents may wish to shadow or alert their children to the need to cross the road safely. Please discuss with the Planner (dirk Nankervis) or Controller (Valerie Brammall) on the day if you have concerns

How Do I Enter?

As these are championship events, **pre-entry is required via Eventor by midnight Mon 4th March.** Eventor will assume that you want to enter all 3 days unless you deselect the races not required.



Do I need an e-stick or P card?

Sportident or P cards are required at all orienteering events in Tasmania. If you do not own a Sportident or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.

How Much Does It Cost To Enter

Junior and Senior elite competitors will pay a surcharge of \$5 extra per event to create a prize pool for elite classes. E.g. M/W21E will pay \$15 per event and M/W17-20E will pay \$10 per event. All other competitors will pay the Orienteering Tasmania fee.

Notes:

1. Adult is 21 years and over at 31 December next
Youth is under 21 years at 31 December next
Concession is Commonwealth Card Holders (pension or health care card)
Family is any number of adult or junior members who are part of a family
2. Children 10 years and under completing a course as a member of a group in the company of adults or older children, participate free of charge.
3. A child completing a course as an individual with a parent shadowing (following) them only pays the relevant child entry fee. That is, the parent shadowing does so free of any charge.

What Else Do I Need To Know?

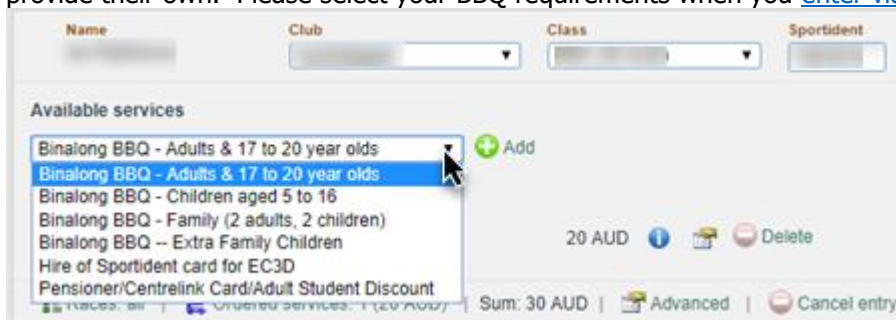
