SPRINT

Location: The assembly area is the north end of Spring Creek Recreational Reserve, Torquay.

Directions: Take Westgate Freeway to Geelong and follow signs to Torquay. Proceed through Torquay on the Surf Coast Highway and at the roundabout complete a U turn and head back along the Surf Coast Hwy for 250 metres to the north entrance to Spring Creek Recreational Reserve. (O-signs) **Do not enter Spring Creek Recreational Reserve at the roundabout.**

Map: *Spring Creek* – Scale: 1:5000, 5m contours.

This is a new map that includes tracks and paths along Spring Creek, the adjoining parks and reserves, and nearby suburban streets. A mix of bitumen roads, shared paths, dirt roads, grass areas and single tracks.

Entries: Enter online through Eventor. Online entries close at midnight Tuesday 12th March.

Online entry fees:

Adults \$10, Juniors (20 and under) \$5.

Limited on-the-day entries are possible depending on available maps.

On-the-day entry fees: Adults \$15, Juniors \$8.

Courses: 4 line courses, score and a children's course. Choose whichever length course you like.

Course 1: 7.5 km – 19 controls

Course 2: 6.5 km – 17 controls

Course 3: 5.5 km – 15 controls

Course 4: 4.5 km – 12 controls

Score course: 30 minutes – visit as many controls as you can in any order.

Special Children's Course: 1.5 km. A special small children's course with 6 animal coded controls to find on a simple circuit. FREE ENTRY. Children to be accompanied by an adult.

COURSE SETTER NOTES

- You are only permitted to ride on mapped roads and tracks, parking areas, and open areas shown using the orange “rideable area” symbol.
- Please be aware that the area is not closed to the public and therefore all road laws need to be followed and care taken when on roads and shared tracks.
- Thank you to Torquay Tigers Cricket Club for use of the Reserve and facilities and thanks to Surf Coast Shire Council for enabling the event.

On the day

Registration opens at 9.00 am.

Sportident electronic timing will be used. Loan SI sticks will be available at Registration.

Start times: from 10.00am to 11.00am. Allowance made for any family groups needing more of an overlap in timing. Earlier starts may be possible.

The Start: is at the assembly area

Warm Up area: Riders MUST NOT warm up inside the Spring Creek Reserve – you must use the service road along the Surf Coast Hwy just outside the Spring Creek Reserve entrance.


Courses close at 12 noon All riders must finish by that time as controls will be brought in from then.

Location: Great Ocean Rd Chocolaterie

Directions: From Spring Creek Reserve proceed 14km towards Anglesea along the Great Ocean Rd. Turn right at Elkington Rd and then immediately left into the Great Ocean Road Chocolaterie. Parking is at the north end of the car park.

Map: *Eumeralla* – Scale: 1:10,000, 5m contours.

The map is native coastal forest with management vehicle tracks and mountain bike single tracks. Most tracks offer good fast riding but there are some sandy patches.

Entries: Enter online through Eventor. Online entries close at midnight Tuesday 12th March 2019.

Online entry fees: Orienteering Victoria member – \$15 Adult, \$5 Junior. Non member: \$25 Adult, \$5 Junior.

Limited on-the-day entries are possible depending on available maps.

On-the-day entry fees: OV members: \$20 adults, \$10 juniors. Non members: \$30 adults, \$10 juniors.

Courses: 4 line courses or a score course. Choose whichever length course you like.

Course 1: 19.0km – 13 controls

Course 2: 15.5km – 11 controls

Course 3: 12.0km – 10 controls

Course 4: 8.0km – 8 controls

Score course: 75 minutes – visit as many controls as you can in any order.

COURSE SETTER NOTES

- You are only permitted to ride on mapped roads and tracks, parking areas, and areas shown using the orange “rideable area” symbol
- Please be aware that the area is not closed to the public. Take care if you see other riders or park users
- Thank you to Parks Victoria for permitting use of the park

On the day

Registration opens at 12.00 am.

Sportident electronic timing will be used. Loan SI sticks will be available at Registration.

Start times: from 1.00pm to 2.30pm. Allowance made for any family groups needing more of an overlap in timing. Earlier starts may be possible.

The Start: is 1km from the assembly area. Follow the taped route along the vehicle exit from the Chocolaterie. This exit road runs along the side of the Gt Ocean Rd for 600m to a large roundabout. With care, use the roundabout to cross the Gt Ocean Rd and then immediately turn left into the park and the event start.

The Finish: is close to the Start. To return to the Assembly area, re-cross the Gt Ocean Rd roundabout and ride back up the exit road to the Chocolaterie. Keep left and take care of any cars exiting the Chocolaterie.


Courses close at 4.00pm All riders must finish by that time as controls will be brought in from then.
