The Level 1 course is ideal for orienteering coaches intending to work with beginner and intermediate participants. Coaches focus on preparing athletes to progress through moderate toward hard navigation skills. Coaches learn to develop a friendly, supportive and social coaching environment.

Activity

This is a single session coaching accreditation course that will involve an initial indoor seminar followed by practical activities in the adjacent parklands.

At the completion of the course, participants will:

- Organising and setting practical navigation training activities
- Developing and progressively challenging athletes
- Building success through self-awareness and analyses.
- Developing and monitoring physical and mental frameworks for athlete progression as well as the confidence to approach and engage orienteers of all abilities.
- Knowledge of resources available for conducting such exercises.

This course can be recognized for credit toward achieving a level 2 coaching accreditation.

Course Requirements

In addition to attending this course you will need to:

- Complete the free online "Community Coaching General Priniciples Certificate". Teachers do not need to complete the online course.
- Possess a current Working with Children Check (or teacher registration)
- Be a member of Orienteering Victoria (or another state orienteering association)
