Lal Lal State Forest, south of Yendon and Lal Lal Sunday 14 April 2019

<u>Location & Directions</u>: The assembly area is at the *intersection* of Mt Doran Road and Andersons Road. Take the Western Highway to Gordon, travel south to Mt Egerton, travel west (past the new windfarm) to Yendon; then south (o-sign) to Lal Lal, follow Coalmine Rd (dirt road), then left into Haywood Rd, right into Mt Doran Rd to the Andersons Rd intersection; park as directed in the paddock.

<u>Entries</u>: Enter online through *Eventor*. Online entries close Wednesday, 10 April at 11.59pm. Online entries: Adults \$18; Juniors \$5.

On-the-day entries: Adults \$23; Juniors \$8 - possible if there are available maps. Sport Ident timing will be used. Hire a SI stick for \$3.

<u>Course Planners Notes</u>: Tracks (dirt) are mostly 4WD with single tracks linking the main grid. Woodcutters (south west corner of the map) have made small short tracks (shown on map as dots) that come off the main track.
