This series is especially intended for those whose families who have other activities on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

#### **About This Event:**

The courses will be in the seldom visited area west of the dam wall. Some faint vehicle tracks will help navigation. There is generally good running in bush areas. A compass would be useful in some of the areas where contours are subtle. Long course participants will have route choices that include steep climbs and descents but be rewarded with spectacular views of the Derwent.

The gates of the reserve will be locked at 4:30 pm so we need to have all controls collected and all equipment packed by that time. Hence the earlier starting time window.

### Where is the Start?

The Assembly Area will be the two sandstone huts at the eastern end of the main car park at the reserve.

Start and Finish will be on the western side of the dam. Allow 15 minutes to walk 900 meters across the dam to the Start. The download computer will be at the Assembly Area.

#### When Can I Start?

Start any time between 12:00 midday and 2pm. Note the earlier starting time window.

# When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 3pm. Control collection will commence at that time.

Be back to the Assembly area by course closure time if you haven't completed your course. And everyone must download in Assembly area computer so we know you are back safely and don't have to organize a search party.

## What Are The Courses?

The following courses will be available. There may be some minor changes to the details below:

Long: 4.5km 139 m Elevation Hard navigation

Medium 3.0 km 65 m Elevation Hard Moderate navigation

Short: 2 km 55 m Elevation Moderate Easy navigation

Novice: 1.5 km 30m Elevation Very Easy Navigation

# Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
