7. When Are Start Times?

See spreadsheet on page 4. As these are sprint races, start intervals will be 1 minute. Races 2 and 6 will involve 1 or more (mini) mass starts. Pre-allocated start times will be available on the OT website in the week leading up to the events and will be displayed at events. Enter on the day participants will be started at the organiser's discretion.

8. What Are The Courses?

Each event (except event 4) will have 3 courses (long, medium and short), each with a male and female class. Event 4 (Tasmanian sprint champs) will have the usual 9 OST courses & classes. All courses are "sprint length" (~0.5 -3.5km) but with distances measured along the "red line" rather than along the optimal route. Some extra information about the format of each event will be given in a briefing prior to each event. See spreadsheet for course lengths.

9. Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
