COURSES

There are three length courses

BOXERS (about 2.8 km)

BRIEFS (about 2.0 km primarily offered as a non-competitive course for sub-juniors and novices)

COMPETITIONS

Boardies and Boxers offer 3 possible competitions

Saturday Best - Highest combined placings on Saturday's 2 events.

Sunday Best - Highest combined placings on Sunday's 2 events

Newcastle Shorts Weekend Champion - Runner's best 3 placings to count over weekend.

If you are.....

ENTERING A SINGLE EVENT

Select the event and enter one of the classes with that days suffix. Eg If a Sunday event use "SU" suffix.

ENTERING TWO EVENTS ON THE SAME DAY

Select the events and enter one of the classes with that days suffix. For the Saturday event select suffix "SA" and for Sunday select "SU" suffix. Select the same class for both events to be in the relevant competition.

ENTERING TWO EVENTS ON DIFFERENT DAYS

Select the events and enter one of the classes with that days suffix. For the Saturday event select suffix "SA" and for Sunday select "SU" suffix. You don't need to run the same class.

ENTERING THREE OR FOUR EVENTS

Select the events and enter one of the classes with a weekend "WE" suffix. Use the same class for all events if you wish to be in the weekend competition.

MIXING CLASSES

Of course you can enter different classes on the same or different days but you'll need at least two similar classes on at least one day to qualify for any competition.
