Facilities and Opportunities

The Adekate Camp is located 800m from the eastern edge of Creswick Diggings: an extensive competition area consisting of large areas of spur/gully terrain and international standard goldmining. Creswick Diggings is part of the Ballarat / Creswick contiguous map block; other international standard competition areas are a very short distance away: Petticoat Gully, St George's Lake, Chapel Flat, Nerrina etc. The camp is also mapped (63 hectares of native bush) and is suitable for relays and night orienteering activities.

The camp includes all the usual school camp facilities: heated rooms and bathrooms; dining hall, rec hall, oval, firepit etc.
