

ENTRY INFORMATION

Stonehenge Sunday 30th June 2019

Statewide OST 8

New area and map produced by Mike Morffew 2019.

Dalmeney Park, Stonehenge.

Scale 1:15 000 for courses 1&2.

Scale 1:10 000 for all other courses. 5m contour interval.

Dolerite terrain, gently undulating with subtle contour detail. Generally, very runnable and open forest except for areas of stony ground and numerous gorse thickets.

Start Area

From Launceston.

Travel to Oatlands. From High St, Oatlands (the main rd), turn SW onto C312 Tunnack Rd. After 4.5km, turn left onto C310 Inglewood Rd and continue for 20.8km. Assembly area will be in the field on the left.

From Hobart several options exist.

Via **Oatlands** (approx. 109km from Hobart GPO).

Via **Sorell** (approx. 92km from Hobart GPO).

Via **Richmond** (approx. 91km from Hobart GPO).

From **Oatlands** - follow directions as per travelling from Launceston

From **Sorell** travel along the A3 for 21km to Runnymede. Turn left onto C312 Woodsdale Rd and head north for 22km continuing through Levendale. At Woodsdale, turn left onto C318 and continue for 9.7km. Turn right onto C310 Stonehenge Rd and continue for 11.9km. At the T junction with Inglewood Rd, turn left and continue along C310 Inglewood Rd for 3.8km. Assembly area will be in the field on the right.

Alternatively – travel through **Richmond** and Campania on the B31 to Colebrook. Immediately past Colebrook, turn right onto C313 Rhyndaston Rd. After 1.2km turn right on the C342 Eldon Rd. and continue for 12.6km to Tunnack. Turn left and continue north along the C312 Tunnack Rd for 4.9km. Turn right onto C310 and head east for 15.7km. At the T junction with Inglewood Rd, turn left and continue along C310 Inglewood Rd for 3.8km. Assembly area will be in the field on the right.
