Parking & Directions

Head North from Maidenwell along Kingaroy Cooyar Rd. Follow O-signs to farm (a right turn approx 2km from town). Park as directed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION RECAP

- **No TOILETS** at assembly area, available in town en route (approximately 2km away).
- Some water on course, **LIMITED water** at assembly area. Please BYO.
- **Some body cover is recommended.** The first part of course has more lantana than a month ago.
- **No Enter on the Day**
- On most courses, there will be **multiple fence crossings**. Please respect these and any damage should be reported to organiser. **Most fences can be crossed by rolling under** and this will limit the risk of any damage. The posts are often wobbly and to cross at a post you will be stepping directly onto barbwire so may weaken the fence. This is a great new map that can be extended, and we ask that you take an extra second to cross a fence to minimise any risk of damage.
- The **very easy course** will have a section of tape, approximately 50m. Young competitors are expected to be able to **follow a powerline** (look up!) so you may wish to show them what powerlines and pylons look like on a map prior to the event.
- The farmer often drives his ute around to cut logs, pick up rocks etc; these may appear as tracks in real life but not necessarily appear on the map -- they frequently come and go.
- Safety is North to fence.
