Directions and Assembly: From Wivenhoe Dam on the Brisbane Valley Highway go North for 4.5kms and turn right on Hay Road which becomes Fig Tree Road. Turn right before closed gate on Sheepstation Inlet Road and continue to assembly area in 200 metres. From the North, turn Left on Hay Road as above, approx. 24 kms from Esk. The Ranger requests that no animals be brought on to the property. Public Toilet available at Assembly Area.

Pre-Entry: Please pre-enter by 11.59pm on Thursday 27 June to guarantee a map. Some spares will be printed but it would help the organisers considerably if you could pre-enter. Pay on the day.

SI electronic timing will be used. SI sticks can be hired at \$2 each..
