**1. Location** Wild Dog Creek, Levendale

**2. Date** 14 July 2019

**4. Event Series Information:** Badge and OST 9

### **5. About This Event**

9 courses to suit all ages and levels of orienteering.

Scale 1:15 000,5m contour interval for courses 1, 2 & 3.

Scale 1:10 000,5m contour interval for all other courses.

The topography is very runnable with open forest and areas of stony ground and steep gullies. Due to the dry conditions marshes can be ill defined. Please be aware that cows may be on the course.

There is a five hundred metre walk to the start from the assembly area. The parking area is adjacent to the assembly area.

### **6. Where Is The Start Area?**

From the south, take the A3 to Runnymede. Turn left onto C312 at the orienteering sign and drive for 10.5km towards Levendale. Turn right onto Back Levendale Road for 500 metres and then turn right at the sign for 3.5 km along a rough farm track to the assembly area (allow 15 minutes on farm track). This track is steep, rough and stony in some sections. Please shut all farm gates as there are sheep and cattle in the paddocks.

From the north, turn left at Oatlands and follow the C312 through Tunnack and continue on C312 (now called New Country Marsh Road) to Levendale. Continue until you see the orienteering sign at Back Levendale road. Turn left at the sign for 500 metres and then turn right at the sign for 3.5 km along a rough farm track to the assembly area (allow 15 minutes on farm track). This track is steep, rough and stony in some sections. Please shut all farm gates as there are sheep and cattle in the paddocks.

### **7. When Are Start Times?**

Starts are between 10:00am and 12noon. Course closure 1:30pm.

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
