Courses:

Hard Open Teams of 2, 3 or 4 members.

Legs: Hard navigation 2.2 – 2.3 km.

Hard Masters Teams of 2, 3, or 4 members for men over 50 and women over 45.

Legs: Hard navigation 1.9km.

Mixed Teams of 3 members.

Legs: Hard using a Masters Team course around 1.9 km.

Medium course around 1.8 km.

Easy course of 1.5 km (shadowing of < 12-year olds is allowed on this course).

Entry and payment are via Eventor only:

You can run one or two legs in Hard Open or Hard Masters teams and you can indicate this under Services (1 Leg, 2 Legs). There is no charge for running a second leg.

Club Convenors will allocate teams on Eventor and everyone will be notified about the teams prior to the event.

At the event: From 9.00am Club Convenors will collect packets of chest numbers for their teams from the caravan and they will distribute them to one person in each team.

Team members must wear chest numbers. The running order is: white 1st leg, blue 2nd leg, yellow 3rd leg, red 4th leg. For teams with two runners the 1st leg runner must then run leg 3 and the 2nd leg runner must run leg 4. For teams with three runners the 1st leg runner must run leg 3.

There will be a briefing at 9.30am.

Start Time: Hard Course Teams: 9.40am, Masters Course Teams 9.42am, Mixed teams 9.44am.

There will be a mass start at 11.00am for any remaining runners.

Courses Close: 12.30pm

Facilities: Public Toilet in picnic area. There is no water on courses.

Bring: E-tag and compass. Control descriptions will be printed on the map.

Map: The scale of the map is 1:4000 with 2.5m contour intervals.

Scoring method

Hard Open Teams: 30 points for 1st team, declining to 1 point for 30th team.

Hard Masters Teams: 25 points for 1st team, declining to 1 point for 25th team.

Mixed Teams: 20 points for 1st team, declining to 1 point for 20th team.

The club with the most points is awarded the Ruddy Rock Interclub relay trophy. If there is a tie the club with more points in the Hard category wins.

B-O points are allocated as usual according to the final order of the clubs.

Unofficial teams

The Organiser may make up teams from “leftover” members from different clubs but these will not count towards the Ruddy Rock or B-O Trophies.

Directions: Enter JFNP Main Entrance off Great Eastern Highway and proceed to the Tavern/picnic area. There will not be a sign on Great Eastern Highway but a Turn sign will be at the entrance road. Fees apply (card only). The Start is adjacent to the one-way exit from the

parking/picnic area. Park anywhere in the designated parking areas or on the eastern side of the exit road which is actually quite close to the Start.
