Course 3 – 2 maps, 4.2 k

Course 1 – 1 map, 2.7k

Course closure 12:30

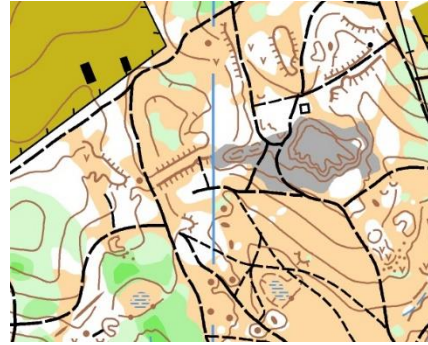
Directions. Assemble at California Gully Primary School, Staley St, California Gully.

Maps:

**New St Mungo** – gold mining terrain with a mix of open forest, low visibility regrowth patches and DELWP mulched clearings. All courses. Start at California Gully Primary School.

**St Just's Point** – gold mining in a mix of open parkland and fire regrowth. Course 1 only. Assembly Buckle St California Gully.

**New Argus** – park-like gold mining terrain. Courses 1,2,3. Assembly corner of Lester and Murchison Street, Eaglehawk.

**South Star** – gold mining terrain in a wilder environment with variable vegetation. Courses 1,2. Assemble corner of Lester and Murchison St, Eaglehawk.
