4. Event Series Information:

OST Statewide Series No. 13

5. About This Event:

This is the thirteenth event in the Statewide OST Series and doubles as the middle-distance championships. This event is being held on the Northern end of the Glen Stuart map which has not been used for some years. The mapping including vegetation boundaries remains extremely accurate. The assembly area offers extensive views across the northern midlands.

The terrain will offer some fast running through open bush land and partially cleared paddocks, particularly towards the end of courses, there are some thickets of gorse and rocky patches. Longer courses will loop through steeper areas with views across to the western tiers.

The usual 9 statewide event courses will be available.

6. Where is the Start Area?

From Evandale travel south on C416 – Nile Road for 8km and turn left onto C419 – Bryants Lane.

Travel along Bryants Lane for 7km and enter through a gate on the left.

- Watch for O signs as you approach the gate.

Parking is available in the paddock as signed.

The assembly area is located 500m up the hill from the parking area and offers views of runners approaching the finish. Allow 10 minutes to walk the 500 m to the Start from the assembly area.

7. When Are Start Times?

Start times are between 10am and 12 midday – Course closure is 1pm.

8. Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events.
