

## Sun 22 September      *Rosenthal Creek, north of Dalveen*

**Terrain:** Undulating to steep, semi-open to open grazing land with areas of scattered and complex granite.

**Map:** *Rosenthal Creek*; 2016; 1:10,000; 5m contour interval

**Courses:** Hard 1 – 5.6km; Hard 2 – 4.5km; Hard 3 – 3.5km; Moderate 1 – 3.2km; Moderate 2 – 2.3km; Easy – 2km; Very Easy – 1.8km

**Course setter:** Liz Bourne

Sportident will be used for this event so make certain you bring along your SI stick or hire one for \$2. New sticks can also be purchased for \$40.

### **Directions:**

From Warwick, travel approx. 37km south on the New England Highway and turn off at Dalveen. Go past the shop and take the first turn on the left and then left into the old Stanthorpe/Warwick Road. Follow for approx. 8km and turn right into a paddock, just before crossing Rosenthal Creek. Follow signs through to the assembly area. Alternatively, from Warwick take the old Stanthorpe/Warwick Road from the roundabout near the saleyards and travel for approx. 28km before turning left into a paddock, just after crossing Rosenthal Creek.

From Stanthorpe, take the New England Highway 20km north and turn left towards Dalveen village under the Highway. Turn right at Jim Mitchell Park and left into the old Stanthorpe/Warwick Road and follow for approx. 8 km before turning right into a paddock, just before crossing Rosenthal Creek.
