About This Event:

- This is the second of six events that make up the Northern Twilight Series.
- Enjoy suburban street orienteering.
- Walk or run with your mates, friends or family.
- Three courses to suit all ages and fitness levels.

Where is the Start?

The start is at Launceston Church Grammar School near the flagpole.
From Button Street enter the main gates and use the bottom carpark.

When Can I Start?

You can start anytime between 4:00pm and 6:00pm. Starting as early as possible gives you more time to complete the course.

When Do I Have To Finish?

You need to finish before the course is closed at 6:30pm. If you will not be able to complete your course in time you will need to abandon it and head back to the assembly area to arrive by course closure time. Whether or not you have completed your course, you must download your SI at the computer, so that we know you have returned safely, and don't organise a search party for you. Also be aware that as soon as the course is closed, the organisers start bringing in controls.

What Are The Courses?

There will be three courses available:

Course 1 – 3.3km, moderate navigation

Course 2/Walkers – 2.3km, easy to moderate navigation.

Course 3 – 1.2km, easy navigation.

Do I need an e-stick or P card?

All Tasmanian Orienteering clubs use the SportIdent (SI) electronic punching system so an e-stick or

a P card is required at all events. If you do not own an e-stick or P card, you can hire one for \$4 at the event. These are also available for purchase at most events. Please note that P-cards are not suitable for courses with more than 19 controls, so talk to the registration team if you have this problem.

How Do I Enter?

Enter on the day, discount available if paying for the full series, get six events for the price of four!
