## Out of Bounds Areas

Prior to your run

The area of the carpark and road to the main entrance is available for warmup.  
All other areas around the school are out of bounds

While running

Out of Bounds areas are marked on your map with either olive green or purple.  
Some areas may also be marked in the field with red and white tape.

## Control Etiquette

All competitors must take care due to narrow passages and possibility of runners coming in the other direction.

Parents please brief your children.

At control stands you must punch and move away quickly.

If you have not planned your route to the next control move away before map reading.

## Start

The start is 100 metre walk from the arena. Follow pink tapes.

## Start Procedure

At entrance to Start Boxes make sure you have cleared your stick

Start Time - 3 min	Box One	Check name
Start Time - 2 min	Box Two	Collect Control Description
Start Time -1 min	Box Three	Map Trays
Start Time 0 min		GO

## Late Start

See late start official

You will be started using a start punch at the next available half minute

Volunteers will also use start punch

## SIAC stick operation

Controls will be operating in SI Air contactless punching mode.

The SIAC Battery check station and the Clear station will be located at the prestart area.

The Check station will be located in the -3min start box.

## Using SI Air

With SI Air you do not have to 'punch' the control, only bring the stick close to the SI unit.

The SI Air stick will flash and beep when it has registered.

The range is between 30 & 40 cm around the unit and a little more above it.

Touching a unit or swiping the air very close to it are the safest methods.

If you think your card has not flashed and beeped, then punch in the normal manner.

## Other Items

Toilets are located on the course map ONLY access is to follow the taped route around the tennis courts

Presentations will be about 12.00 as soon as results have been confirmed.

Protests A jury will be assembled from people available on the day.

Course Closure will be at 12.15pm control pickup will begin immediately after this

Enter on the Day will be available for courses 4 +5 only. See Registration first

Spikes are not allowed.
