

2019 NSW Sprint Championships

Sunday, November 10

Sydney University, Camperdown/Darlington (City) campus

Location: Cadigal Green, Darlington. Access via Maze Crescent off Butlin Ave. If driving, turn into Butlin Ave from City Rd, or walk from Redfern railway station. The campus north of City Rd is embargoed on Nov 10 until you have completed your race.

Parking is in Maze Crescent and adjacent streets. On campus roads parking is \$4 per hour.

Terrain (please read and ensure all competitors understand this): Gently sloping tertiary campus with almost all running on hard surfaces. Can be slippery if wet. No metal studs or spikes permitted.

You will cross City Rd at pedestrian traffic lights on your way to the start but you must use the footbridge while you are racing on the course. City Rd is out of bounds during your race.

There is some vehicle traffic on the campus so please be aware when crossing or running on the roads.

There will be other people around the university campus, especially at the Quadrangle. The Quad is a tourist destination, but most visitors stay only a short time. You are free to use the mapped passageways around the Quad but please show courtesy to others at all times. Be careful running around corners and give way to others if there is any doubt.

Some small open (yellow) areas are roped off temporarily and we cannot know if they will be accessible on race day. They have been taken into account when setting the course and there is no time lost by avoiding these areas. All roped off areas are out of bounds regardless of their status on the map.

Punching System: SPORTident electronic timing with a punching start. SIAC Air+ contactless punching will be enabled, but not at finish SI unit. SIAC sticks will not be available for hire; if you want to use Air+ you will need to bring your own. Standard SI Sticks can be hired with registration in Eventor (\$4).

Start: Follow the streamers, you will walk up stairs then back down to City Rd. Cross at pedestrian lights, then walk straight onwards to start. Approximately 300m and 10 minutes walk.

Results: Bring your smart phone – results should be on liveresults.bigfootorienteurs.com

Presentations: We expect to award class placegetters in a series of presentations as classes finish and results are confirmed. Please don't wander off if you do well!

ONSW presentations will be held after the final event awards

Toilets: We have permission to use toilets inside the entrance to the Noel Martin University Sports Centre, 100m from the assembly. The centre is on Maze Crescent South facing the car park

Water: No water is provided, nor cups. There is a bubbler & refill station on the footpath near the road at the assembly. Please bring your own water bottle or favourite drinking vessel.
