Preview

Big Foot Productions are pleased to bring you the 22nd edition of Australia's longest-running Sprint-O event (possibly the longest in the Southern Hemisphere).

Details

Start times for the first sprint are 9.00am to 10.00am, with the second sprint to start at 11.00am + first sprint time (i.e. if you took 15 mins on course 1 your start time would be 11.15am for course 2).

To be included in the chasing start you need to be finished by 10.30am and take under 60 minutes. If you do not manage these conditions, then you can still run the second course and can start at any time between 11.00am and 12.00noon using a punching start.

A late split start is available on course two using a punching start, the chasing starters will start with no punch.

Anyone only wanting to complete one course is welcome to do so and should enter the 'Short' course, unfortunately you will not be eligible for the traditional chocolate prizes!

SIAC+ technology will be enabled on the controls but NOT for the start (for the chasing start no one will have to punch the start control) or the finish.

Courses

Big Foot Sprints is run over two courses, both in the region of 3km (optimum route) with winning times (M21) of 12 minutes each.

The second course is where the fun starts and is run as a true chasing start. You can expect some closely fought finishes.

Classes

As always only two; open men and open women and everybody runs the same courses.

Entries

Enter online [here](#). Online entry is only required and available for Big Foot Sprints.

Fees for Big Foot Sprints (seniors): \$15 member of an orienteering club, \$19 non-member

Fees for Big Foot Sprints (under 21 at 31/12/2019): \$10.00 members, \$14.00 non-member

Entries close midnight Thursday 19th December.

Entry on the day may be available depending on the number of pre-entries for \$20.00. Add \$4 if you are not a club member. **To guarantee a run you are advised to pre-enter!**

SportIdent stick hire will be available for \$4. Lost rental sticks will be charged at \$40.

Map: Callan Park 1:5000.

Course and Terrain Notes

The courses are run on a mixture of hard surface and grass. If it is dry then flat road shoes will be fine but if wet then more grippy footwear may be better. Shoes with metal studs are not suitable.

The area is made up of buildings of irregular shapes spread over a grassy slope. It is very runnable and the courses should test your ability to make decisions quickly.

To make the most of the area the courses cross over themselves several times. Please take care to check you are going to the correct control especially if you are caught up in the excitement of the chasing start.

Parking: Please park Waterfront Drive if possible. If you are arriving after first start beware of runners as you drive through the grounds.

Toilets: Available on site.
