"2020" NSW Championships being held in 2021!!

After being postponed in 2020 – the "2020 NSW Championships" are planned for the week after Easter 2021.

(The **2021** NSW Orienteering Championships will be held in Sept 2021.)

Garingal welcomes you back to Eugowra – the home of the 2004 Australian Championships. The Seldom Seen map presents a real orienteering challenge that will test your orienteering skills in complex granite terrain.

This weekend of high-quality orienteering includes the "2020" NSW Middle Distance Championship on Saturday and "2020" Long Distance Championship on Sunday. Neither event will be included in the 2021 NSW State League point score.

Please keep informed of the latest news about the event which will be posted on the Eventor Web Page. An "event" will also be maintained on the Garingal Facebook page with news updates.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this event will be conducted in compliance with all Public Health Orders and Government guidelines that apply at event time. Physical distancing and other management strategies are expected to apply for the event.

Location:



Eugowra, NSW is about 82km west of Orange (60 Min drive), 350km from Sydney airport (allow 5-6 hours), 250km from Canberra Airport (allow 3.5 hours).

Program:

Saturday 10th April 2021 **– "2020"** NSW Middle Distance Championship Sunday 11th April 2021 **- "2020"** NSW Long Distance Championship

Entry Procedure and Fees:

Pre-entry and payment of fees for the two events can only be made through **Eventor**.

Enter on the Day (EOD):

There will be a limited number of Enter On Day maps; but not all hard courses will be available (EOD HL, EOD HS, EOD M, EOD E, EOD VE).

String courses will not be available.

Family Discount - The family discount aims to help keep the sport of orienteering affordable for families. A family is defined as 2 adults plus any number of their junior or subjunior dependents. The fourth family member and any subsequent family members will not be charged an entry fee for events. This is automatically calculated by Eventor as long as all family members are entered at the same time as part of one combined entry. On the confirmation screen under Order entry, you will see that the family discount is applied.

Age Class at "2020" - Class / Course

As this is the 2020 Championships (being held in 2021) you will be running in your age class as if it were 2020. Please enter the event using you age class in 2020 - Just pretend the last year with COVID-19 had not happened!

Please note that \$1 of the entry fee on each day will be given to the Landholders to recognise their support and assistance for our Orienteering event.

Punching System:

SPORTident timing will be used for both events.

All field units will be enabled for SIAC contactless punching.

Closing date for entries:

Standard Entries : Sunday 21 March 2021 - midnight

Late Entries : Sunday 28 March 2021 – midnight – a \$10 late entry fee will apply.

The Rules:

Competition Rules: In addition to Orienteering Australia Competition Rules, competitors should familiarise themselves with <u>ONSW Competitors Rules for Foot Orienteering</u>.

Shadowing - "M/W10N"

Orienteers in M/W10N shall be permitted to receive assistance on the course (shadowing or direct assistance) and shall also be given the opportunity to study their course with a parent or mentor for up to 10 minutes before their start time. M/W10N is not an orienteer of the year class. Times shall not be recorded for this class.

Shadowing parents or coaches must run their own course before shadowing novices.

Start Times:

There will be pre-allocated start times and a punching start.

Split Starts:

Families requiring split start times should kindly email the organiser (Rod Eckels rod@slekce.com) with your preference details before 24 March 2021.

Insurance:

Insurance against accidents and in case of injury is the responsibility of participants. We strongly recommend overseas participants have appropriate travel insurance.

Risk Waiver & Acknowledgments (including Parents and Guardians Acknowledgements)

It is a condition of entry that participants agree to the Entry Terms and Conditions for this event, which are available on Eventor as a document. The Entry T&Cs include a waiver and acknowledgment of risks and use of photographs including for parents and guardians of any children who enter.

COVID-19

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this event will be conducted in compliance with all Public Health Orders and Government guidelines that apply at event time. Physical distancing and other management strategies are expected to apply for the event. Further information will be included regarding what measures will apply closer to the event.

Should the event need to be postponed or cancelled or entrants are unable to participate due to COVID-19 restrictions or health issues, refunds of entry fees will be made available.
