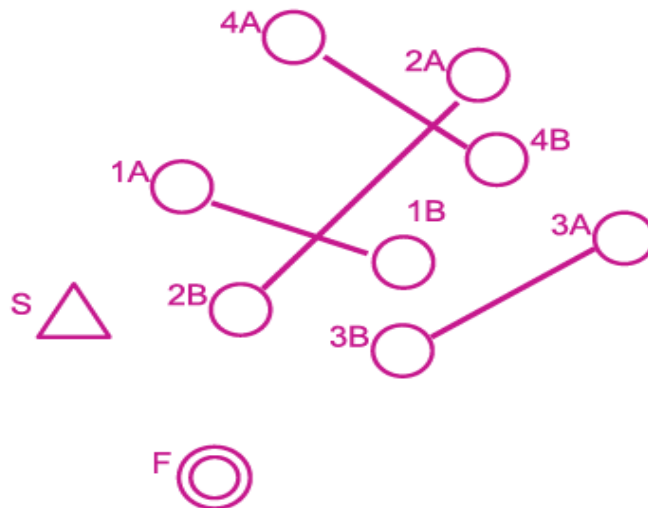


INSTRUCTIONS MYSTERY EVENT

- There are 20 controls in the terrain (and on the map).
- Controls are “paired”: pair 1, pair 2, pair 3, etc. up to pair 10
- On the map: (see picture below with 4 pairs shown).
 - The 2 controls of each pair are numbered 1A/1B, 2A/2B, 3A/3B, etc.... up to 10A/10B.
 - The two circles of each pair are connected by a line (making them look like dumbbells – hence the course names).
 - There is no line connecting the start to pair 1, pair 1 to pair 2 etc.
- The SI boxes in the terrain are numbered 41 to 60. The SI numbers match up with each pair as follows: pair 1 is 41 & 51; pair 2 is 42 and 52, etc. This is clearly shown on the control description.

- Depending on your course you have a certain number of pairs to visit:
 - For the Heavyweight course all 10 pairs have to be visited in numerical order. Pair 1 first, then pair 2, then pair 3 etc... until all 10 pairs have been visited. Course length: ~3.5 km.
 - For the Middleweight course only 7 pairs of your choosing have to be visited in incremental numerical order. That means you can leave out 3 pairs. Course length ~ 2.5km.
 - For the Lightweight course only 5 pairs of your choosing have to be visited in incremental numerical order. That means you can leave out 5 pairs. Course length ~ 1.7km
- **You may visit the two controls of each pair in either order.** For instance you could start by going to 1A followed by 1B OR go to 1B first followed by 1A. Next go to 2A or 2B, etc...
- You **CAN NOT** go to either control of pair 2 before going to both controls of pair 1 etc...
- The pairs **have to be visited in incremental numerical order**. For instance pair 1 before pair 3, before pair 4, before pair 6 etc... until all required pairs have been visited. **YOU CAN NOT** go to either control of pair 1, 2, 3, or 4 after you have already visited pair 5.

When Can I Start?

There will be a mass start at 2pm.

When Do I Have To Finish?

Course closure is at 3pm.

There is also a Beginners course of ~ 1.4 km with starts anytime between 2:01 pm and 2:30 pm
