Pre-entry required, preferably by Sun 6th September, although late entries may be accepted up until Tues 8th Sept at the organisers' discretion. After this, no further entries will be possible as maps have to be printed and start times allocated. All entrants must read the COVID-Safe guideline document before entering.

First start will be 10am Sunday Sept 13th. All competitors must attend the registration tent to get their name ticked off. Distance to walk to the start is approx. 600m. No enter-on-the-day will be possible.
