The following information compliments the information previously published on Eventor (see [here](#)).

- Please familiarise yourself with COVID-19 related guidelines (see [here](#)).
- The arena is in the Cataract Gorge Reserve, Basin Road, West Launceston. Follow the orienteering signs once you have arrived at the reserve. Parking in Council's carparks is pay & display, however parking on Basin Rd is free (if you can find a space).
- The event will consist of teams of four members, with two relay team members competing on a medium length course and the remaining team members competing on the longer course. This is a fun event where we welcome friendly competition and hopefully a close finish. For this reason, teams have been randomly selected based on approximate running times of team members attempting to have a mix of ages, clubs and ability. Teams and running order are listed below.
- Map: Cataract Gorge (August 2020)
 - Scale: 1:4,000 for Medium and Long courses.
 - Contour Interval: 2.5 m
- Control descriptions are on the map.
- Start: This will be in the arena.
- There will a briefing at 10.15 am with the mass start for the first relay team member 10.30 am.
- There are no drink controls on any of the courses and no water at the start/finish/arena. Bring and carry all your own.
- There are numerous trees and branches that have not been removed after falling during the recent snow in the area so please take care.
- There will be no results display BUT live results will be available on <https://tasorienteering.asn.au/results/evoc/>
- An emergency phone number is on the map (0456 031 171).
- Please note that the pool fence printed on the map, has not been re-instated due to recent and expected future flooding.

- At the time of writing, the Gorge is not in flood but if rainfall occurs before the event causing rising waters, the northern walkway may be closed.
