General Disclaimer

Due to the uncertainties surrounding the current COVID-19 situation we advise that prior to travelling to events you check for any posts on our Facebook page advising events may have been cancelled or postponed. Postponing or cancellation would only be done if completely necessary and on advice from ONSW or OA.

Why do I need to pre-enter

To facilitate Covid-19 contact tracing, all club events now require you to pre-enter via Eventor, a centralised event and membership management system currently being used by Orienteering Australia. ONSW is using Eventor for management of events and for club memberships.

Entry Cut-Off

NOTE Sydney Orienteering Club members are required to enter by the Friday night for the MTBO events and are currently excluded from foot orienteering events.

Most of our club events will now allow you to enter online right up until the advertised last start time (although we do prefer you to enter a few days ahead so we have an idea of numbers). Keeping entries open means those procrastinators among us can enter the morning of, or even at the actual event if signal is available from your mobile data provider. Obviously you need to be capable of getting to the start before the start window closes.

Registering in Eventor

To enter an event you need to register even if you are not in a club. See the Eventor FAQ section above (if you haven't already) for details on how to register.

Orienteering members of Greater Sydney will be allocated a start time dependant upon their club. These times will be allocated on Friday night and emailed to each competitor. Please enter prior to Friday night!

Parents who need split starts will need to have one start at 9:00 and the other at 10:15 regardless of residential address.

MTBO Class abbreviations and descriptions

LSW	LineScoreWomen	Competitors have 75 minutes to complete a line course and then visit as many score controls as possible.
LSM	LineScoreMen	Competitors have 75 minutes to complete a line course and then visit as many score controls as possible.
ASW	AllScoreWomen	Competitors have 75 minutes to visit as many score controls as possible.
ASM	AllScoreMen	Competitors have 75 minutes to visit as many score controls as possible.

ASE	AllScoreEMob	This class is for riders of electric MTBs. Competitors have 75 minutes to visit as many score controls as possible.
AST	AllScoreTeam	Ride with a friend(s) as a team. Competitors have 75 minutes to visit as many score controls as possible.
ASF	AllScoreFamily	Ride with family members as a team. Competitors have 75 minutes to visit as many score controls as possible.
ОТМ	OtherTeamMember	Used to enter other team members
OFM	OtherFamilyMember	Used to enter other family members
ONC	OfficialNotCompeting	Register if you are helping but not competing

Enter as a team

- Enter subsequent team members selecting "OTM" for class.
- Advise us by email the members of your team

You will only be charged a fee for the "AST" entry and only receive one map for the team. If you require additional maps you can order them via the services option.

Enter as a family

- · Select "Enter and/or order services"
- Enter the first team member selecting "ASF" in the "Class" box via the selection table.
- Enter subsequent team members selecting "OFM" for class.
- Advise us by email your family team members.

You will only be charged a fee for the "ASF" entry and only receive one map for the team. If you require additional maps you can order them via the services option

How to order services

Services are items such as mapboard or SI Stick rentals, extra maps or even discounts if valid. You can order services at time of entry or even at a later time.

The "available services" selection is on the competitor entry/change entry section.

Use the selection table to order what you need

Press the "+ add" to add it to your entry.

You can select and order more services if you need to.
